



Todo List to Start your Small Business in Canada

- Determine the business structure (Sole Proprietorship, Partnership, Corporation)
- Register your business federally
 - Check for name availability and reserve it if necessary
 - Complete the federal business registration form
 - Pay the registration fee.
- Register your business provincially
 - Determine if your business requires provincial registration based on location and business type
 - Fill out the provincial registration paperwork
 - Submit the registration fee
- Obtain necessary municipal permits
 - Identify the required permits for your business operations.
 - Complete the permit applications.
 - Submit the applications along with any required documentation and fees.
- Open a business bank account
- Develop a Business Plan (Here's a [Business Plan Template](#) to get you started)
- Obtain necessary business insurance
- Understand tax requirements and obligations
- Choose a financial management system
- Ask for help from a virtual CFO
